HORTICULTURAL

Flower Show Trophy best in the Horticultural Section

40th Anniversary Cup best 3 identical daffodils in Classes 1 or 2

1. 3 daffodils, trumpets as long or longer than petals
2. 3 daffodils, trumpets less than length of petals
3. Class withdrawn
4. Poeticus narcissi - small eye (e.g. Actaea, Pheasant Eye)
5. 3 daffodils, doubles
6. 3 daffodils, more than one flower per stem
7. Vase of narcissi/daffodils, not more than 10 stems
8. Vase of narcissi/daffodils, dwarf / miniature varieties, no more than 6 stems
9. 3 tulips, any variety
10. 6 stems polyanthus
11. Vase of Spring flowers (not shrubs) exc. daffodils and narcissi
12. Vase of shrubs in bloom, height max. 71 cm from bench, dia. max. 51 cm
13. Pot or bowl of bulbs, any variety, max 3
14. Flowering pot plant (not bulbs) dia. max. 30 cm
15. Foliage pot plant dia. max. 30 cm
16. Any vegetable (one kind). (Ask Secretaries quantity required)
17. 3 sticks of rhubarb with 5/7.5 cm leaf left on
18. Patio pot containing Spring flowers. Pot dia. max. 25 cm

19. An arrangement in a jug. Max.width 45 cms.
20. "EGGSTRA SPECIAL" an exhibit using flowers and foliage.
Max width 45 cms.
21. "A LITTLE BIT OF SPRING" an arrangement in an egg cup.
Max. width/dim 10 cms.
22. "MINE'S A PINT" an exhibit in a beer mug using foliage and/or flowers.
Max. width/dim 30 cms.

Recipe for Apple and Cinnamon Cake (Class 29)

Ingredients:

| | |
|---|------------------|
| 4 eggs | 225gs S.R. flour |
| 225gs sugar (golden granulated or demerara) | |
| 225gs margarine | Milk to mix |
| 1 tspn cinnamon | 2 apples |

Method: Cream margarine and sugar until pale and fluffy. Gradually add eggs, fold in flour and add milk as required. Pour half the mixture in cake tin. Peel and slice one apple and lay slices over mixture then pour in other half of cake mixture. Peel and slice second apple and lay on top of cake mixture. Sprinkle with mix of sugar and cinnamon.

Bake in medium oven at 180 degrees for 45 minutes/1 hour.

48. Any item of handicraft.
49. **UP TO 5 YEARS** - paint a rainbow in any medium (A4 size)
50. **GROUP ENTRY** - build a **SCARECROW** max. width (ie fingertip to fingertip) 122 cms max. height 152 cms. It must be free-standing; we suggest using a cross for the frame and then supporting it in a patio umbrella stand. 3. **The Village Centre will be open from 9 a.m.** on the morning of the Show and **ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE IN PLACE BY 11.00 a.m.** when everyone except Show Officials will be asked to leave so that judging can take place. The Judges' decisions will be final.
4. All ordinary care will be taken of exhibitors' property, but no responsibility can be accepted for any loss or damage.
5. Exhibits not intended for auction are to be removed between 3.45 - 4.00 p.m. please.
